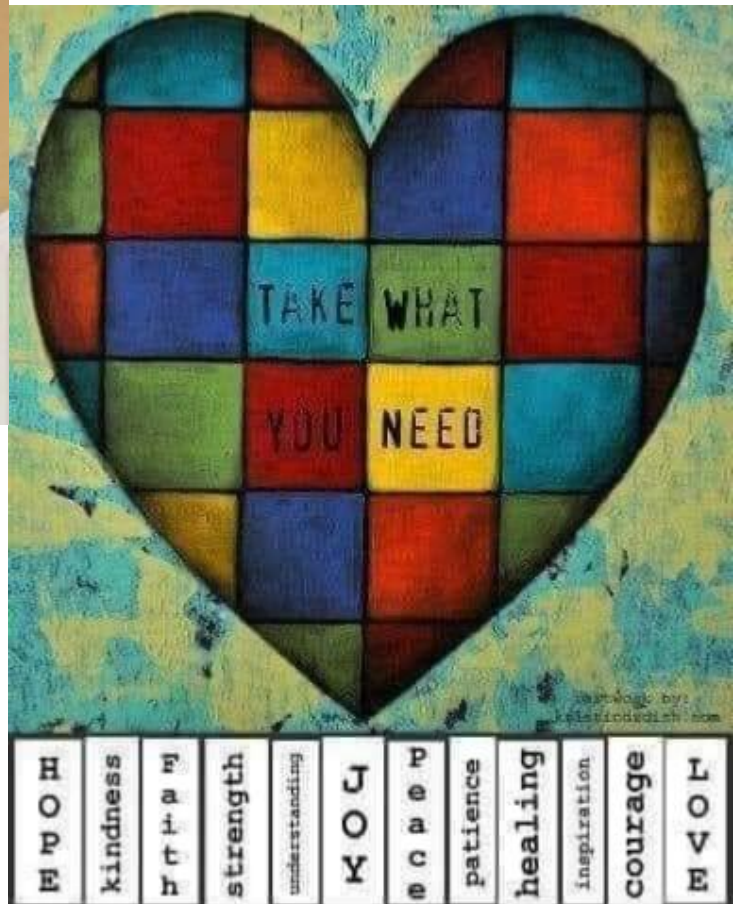

Squad Time: Sunday, March 2, 2025 at 1 p.m.

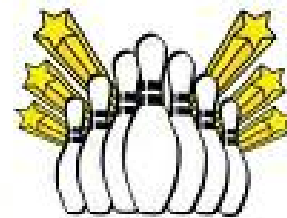
Eligibility: Any combination of 5 person teams. You don't have to be a member of a
