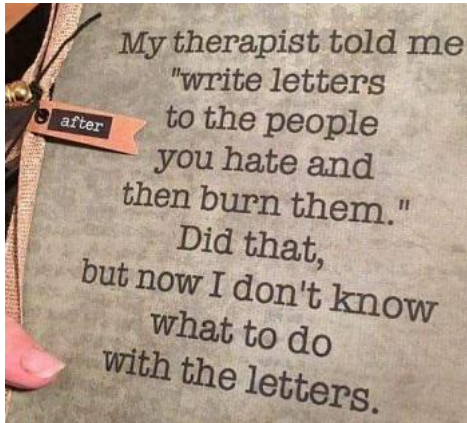

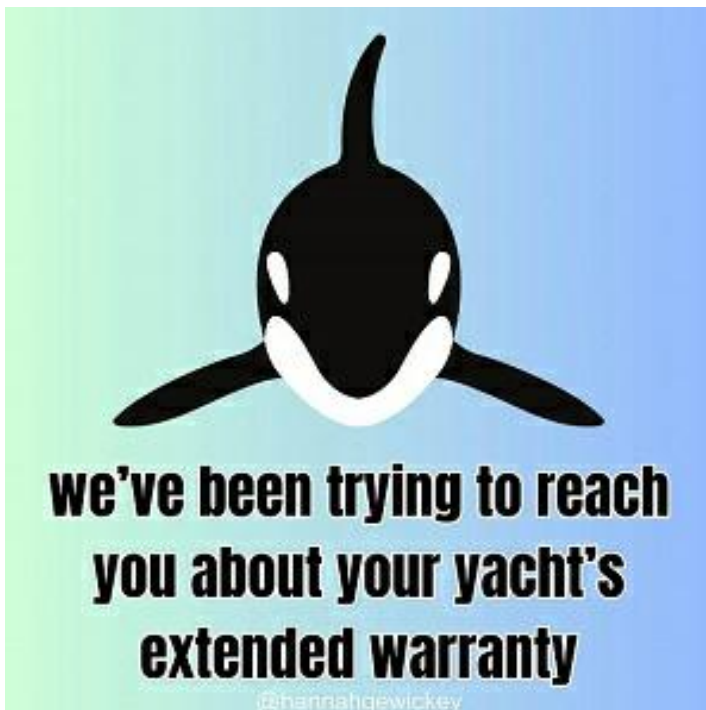
Please come out and share your Lion's Spirit with all of us. Let's show everyone why we are Proud to be East Cocalico Lions.
